

How to reach Salamanca

HOW TO REACH SPAIN



There are two ways to reach Salamanca:

1. There is a coach line Madrid - Salamanca with frequent departures. Coaches leave from 'Estación Sur' (Méndez Álvaro).

To reach the station you can take a taxi (it will cost about 20 euros) or you can take the underground to 'Estación Sur'. The ordinary coach

service takes 3.15 hours to reach Salamanca. The express service is a bit more expensive, but it is quite comfortable and it only takes 2 and a half hours. You can find more information about the timetable at the web page: www.auto-res.net

2. If you prefer to travel by train you should go the Chamartín station in

Madrid. The trip takes two and a half hours. You can find more information about the timetable at the web page: www.renfe.es

Once in Salamanca, the best way to reach your final destination is by taxi.
